  - a. Jesus comes from nowhere
  - b. Jesus in His human nature lived in active submission to the Father's will in every way.
  - c. Jesus' submission led to ongoing satisfaction from the Father.

  - a. Jesus was impelled.
  - b. Jesus battled in the wilderness.
  - c. Jesus sustained obedience in the face of fierce temptation in contrast to Adam and Israel's failures.
